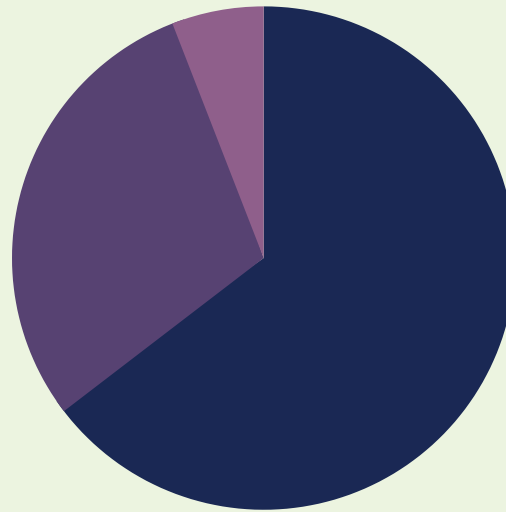

The Architectural Fountain in The Park at City Center received some much needed treatment, including a new pump, repaired nozzles, patched holes, new paint and sealer, chemicals, and is currently working like a charm.



The Downtown Playground Berm had concrete added between the rock scrambles to prevent more breakways and washouts. The drinking fountain at The Park at City Center was also repaired.
